Pastor's Corner...

Dear King of Glory family and friends,

Happy October! Our month of learning about and commemorating the Protestant Reformation's 500th Anniversary is finally here! I hope you enjoyed our first week of Growth Group meetings and our first Sunday of our Re-Formed Sunday sermon series. Here are our themes for this month's sermons looking at the five "solas" of Luther's theology:

Oct. 1st: Authority Reformed Authority (*Sola Scriptura* or Scripture Alone)

Oct. 8th: Identity Reformed Identity (*Solus Christus* or Christ Alone)

Oct. 15th: Justice Reformed (*Sola Gratia* or Grace Alone)

Oct. 22nd: Peace Reformed (*Sola Fide* or Faith Alone)

Oct. 29th: A Life Reformed (*Soli Deo Gloria* or the Glory of God Alone)

I have also started my class on the Reformation which takes place between services in the library. All are welcome to join us and learn a bit more about Luther and the history surrounding the birth of our Lutheran tradition. We will be ending this month on a high note on October 29th which is Reformation Sunday as we gather at our Fall Festival following the 10:30 am service. There will be food and fun for all. We're even working on putting together a film showing of the movie Luther with popcorn, so be sure to mark that day on your calendar. Plus, there will be the usual games, bounce house, cake walk and cotton candy for the little ones. Invite a friend or bring a neighbor. It's sure to be a good time!

Not to get ahead of ourselves, but I also wanted to get a few dates on your calendar for November. We are planning on welcoming new members on All Saints Day, Sunday, November 5th at both services. On that day, we will also be remembering those who are near and dear to us who have passed away this last year. Feel free to bring a picture and light a candle in their memory on that day. Let us celebrate those that have gone on before us as we celebrate those that are newly joining our family of faith. Additionally, we will have three Sundays in November which will be focused on Stewardship in its three traditionally conceived forms: talents, time and treasures. Upcoming Changes to the Patio Cover:

I’m sure you’ve noticed the posts in the covered walkway between Little Ed and the Fellowship Center are no longer standing straight and upright. Over the years, efforts have been made to brace and support the structure. However, we believe it is time to take down the southern section of the patio cover.

We are in the process of investigating the safest and most economical way to remove it. Before it is taken down, the wiring for the lighting and the PVC water pipes will need to be disconnected. Additionally, the sign directing visitors to the accessible restrooms will need to be relocated. Once the cover is removed, additional work will be needed to remove the post footings and fill in the openings with pavers.



Long term planning is needed to figure out how KOG intends on using the patio in the future. One idea that is under consideration is to install an arched opening in the wall at the north end of the patio between Little Ed and Big Ed. The patio pavers might be extended out into the area currently covered by lawn. A fenced in yard could be established so youth from our congregation and the community could have a place to safely play. This is the same area temporarily fenced during VBS each year.

We will keep you updated as to when the demolition will commence.
