Stewardship Update We were thrilled to have such a good turnout at last Sunday's Unity Service and Celebration Luncheon. Many thanks to all who have turned in their Commitment Cards. 64 members pledged to give \$293,968 in 2019 (\$284,968 to the general fund and \$9000 to the facility fund). This is a nice increase over last year's Commitment Sunday numbers: 54 pledges totaling \$261,914. Even more exciting is that we had 8 new pledging members and 32 who chose to increase their pledge. Last year's final amount pledged was \$353,624, so we still have a *little* ways to go. If you have not yet turned in your Commitment Card, please do so. Having this information helps in the planning and budgeting process for next year. You may put your card in the offering basket, drop it off, or mail it to the church office. Indeed, "We are the Church".
